MEDICAL EXPENSES

Medical Expenses are eligible for the tax credit once they EXCEED 3% of your net income.

Example: You earn \$50,000 then the first 3% = \$1,500 is not deductible.

So, if you have \$1,300 in medical expenses, it is NOT deductible at all.

IF, you have \$1,800 in medical expenses, then only \$300 of that is deductible.

Only medical expenses in the calendar year are deductible.
